

Lands and Survey does state proud

KUCHING: The state civil service, represented by Lands and Survey Department, won a triple victory at the just concluded national-level Innovative and Creative Circle (ICC) Convention held at the Royale Bintang Spa and Resort in Seremban, Negri Sembilan, from 31 Oct to 2 Nov.

It was a historic achievement as this was the first time any state had won both the technical and management categories at one time since the ICC was introduced some 28 years ago.

The technical category was represented by "Millennium Sabe" from Lands and Survey Headquarters Kuching, while the management category was represented by Lands and Survey Department, Miri with their ICC group called "4-Quest".

Millennium Sabe scored 81.01 per cent with a five-star rating to be adjudged the winner of the technical category, beating 13 other states while 4-Quest outwit the rest of the 13 teams in the management category to emerge as the champion team.

Both teams lifted their respective Chief Secretary Awards.

The victory became sweeter when Millennium Sabe also won the innovative and creative booth category.
